I have also completed 4 Star BCU training. I have been teaching canoe for 7 years and kayak for 4 years. My approach to instruction is fun, non-threatening, and motivational, with an emphasis on the acquisition of safe, sound skills. When traveling in the wilderness, I practice and promote Leave No Trace skills and ethics.
